

Faith Formation is Making Changes!

Grades 4K-5 will continue to meet on Sunday mornings 9:00-10:15a and will be implementing the <u>Loyola Press</u> <u>Family Catechesis Program</u>. We will be following a hybrid schedule, which will include 2 days per month at the church and 2 days per month with lessons at home. We will also be offering additional family gatherings on select Wednesday evenings.

Grades 6-11 will continue to meet on Wednesday evenings with 4:30-6:30 Social Time & Meal, followed by 6:30-7:30 Class Time.

Grades 6-9 will be using <u>YDisciple, powered by NET</u> <u>Ministries.</u> This program focuses on taking small groups of pre-teens and teens and forming them into Disciples. The lessons and resources are designed to be fun and engaging with content that teaches them our core Catholic values and beliefs.

Grades 10-11 will be combined into one class and will become our two-year Confirmation Prep program. The primary curriculum we will be using is from Ascension Press - <u>Altaration: The Mystery of the Mass Revealed</u> and <u>Chosen: Your Journey to Confirmation.</u>
